



HAZARDOUS ENERGY ISOLATION

This course establishes minimum requirements for securing, locking and tagging out energy-isolating devices and for the protection of workers from the unexpected release of hazardous energy during installation, maintenance, service and repair activities involving hazardous energy sources. Following the CSA Z462 Standard this course is taught by a Master Electrician. Participants leave with knowledge to set up, follow and maintain a successful hazardous energy management program. Students demonstrate hands-on practical lockout techniques to form part of the certification process. Course can be tailored to compliment your current program or be part of a new implementation.

- The importance of locking out machinery and equipment
- Recognizing the dangers of all types of hazardous energy
- Employer and worker responsibilities for safe lockout
- Legislation
- When lockout is required
- Safe Work Practices, Documentation
- Lockout Devices, Isolation
- Roles, Training
- Basic and group lockout procedures
